In France, where droit de suite has been recognized since 1920, the percentage due to the artist or the artist's heirs from any resale is calculated on a sliding scale based on value of the artwork. Duration of the right is life of an artist plus 70 years.

Droit de suite (French for "right to follow") is a right granted to artists or their heirs, in some jurisdictions, to receive a fee on the resale of their works of art. This should be contrasted with policies such as the American first-sale doctrine, where artists do not have the right to control or profit from subsequent sales.

Resale right will be managed by collecting societies; individual artists will not be able to request payments directly. This means that the seller/auction house will be required to pay all royalties to a collecting society who will then distribute them to the artists.

Artist's resale right, or droit de suite, was introduced in January 2006 as a result of an EU Directive. In prescribed situations, it provides an artist with a right to receive a royalty based on the price obtained for the resale of an original work of art, subsequent to the first transfer by the artist.

Artist's resale right

The resale royalty right gives artists the legal right to receive a small share of the resale price on the second and subsequent sales of their works, during their lives and for 70 years after death and, by 2012, the right will be given to the estates of artists who have died within the previous 70 years.
