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### Scoring And Interpretation Of The

The 19 items of the FSFI use a 5-point Likert scale ranging from 1 to 5 with higher scores indicating greater levels of sexual functioning on the respective item. To score the measure, the sum of each domain score is first multiplied by a domain factor ratio (0.6 for desire; 0.3 for arousal; 0.3 for lubrication; 0.4 for orgasm; 0.4 for satisfaction; and 0.4 for pain) in order to place all domain totals on a more comparable scale, and then subsequently summed to derive a total FSFI score. 1

3b. For all significant differences between index scores, the next step is to judge how rare the difference is in the general population. Refer to Table B.2 of the WAIS-IV Administration and Scoring Manual, which provides the cumulative frequency (i.e. base rates) of discrepancies among the WAIS-IV scores in the normative sample.

Scoring is subjective and interpretation complicated as the test involves various skills. Nevertheless, it remains sensitive to visuospatial skills and memory, and relates well to similar tests. Its validity and reliability, apart from test-retest reliability, are generally supported, although research contradictions should be verified.

Scoring the DES-II The DES score is the average of all the questions, so the minimum score is 0 and the maximum score is 100.[2] To calculate this yourself, all the questions are scored by dropping the zero on the percentage of each answer, e.g., 30% = 3; 80% = 8, these numbers are then added up.

Interpreting the Scores. On the Long Form, we generally consider any score of 3 or more on a schema to be meaningful. On the Short Form, any score of 2 or more is usually meaningful. After scoring the YSQ, we explain to the patient which schemas received moderately high scores and which received very high scores.

Cronbach alphas for the SCORE-15 and SCORE-28 totals were 0.90 and 0.93, respectively (Hamilton, Carr, Cahill, Cassells, & Hartnett, 2015). Test-retest reliability: Degree to which the same respondents have the same score after period of time when trait shouldn't have changed: SCORE had good test-retest reliability (Hamilton et al., 2015).

### Systemic Clinical Outcome and Routine Evaluation

One formal definition is that it is "a summary of the evidence contained in an examinee's responses to the items of a test that are related to the construct or constructs being measured." Test scores are interpreted with a norm-referenced or criterion-referenced interpretation, or occasionally both. A norm-referenced interpretation means that the score conveys meaning about the examinee with regards to their standing among other examinees.

This is called a z-score (or normal score) and tells us how many standard deviations a score of 4.167 falls above or below the benchmark. Convert the Z-score to a percentile rank: Using the properties of the normal curve we find out what percent of area falls below the .1388 standard deviations above the mean using a calculator or lookup table, we get .556 or 56%.
